If you or others on your campus plan to sponsor an international education program during the Summer 2012 session, I invite you to submit an application for STOCS Program Eligibility so that students who participate in your program will have the opportunity to apply for a STOCS scholarship. All STOCS Program Eligibility Applications are due December 21, 2011.

Two application forms are enclosed: 1) a full program application and 2) a renewal program application. Directors of any program that was not submitted for full review for the Summer 2011 or Winter 2011-12 cycles must submit a full program application. Directors of programs that have been approved for the Summer 2011 or Winter 2011-12 cycles should complete the renewal program application. A list of already-approved programs is attached for your reference.

Once a program is deemed STOCS-eligible, students planning to participate in that program may apply for a STOCS scholarship to help defer their study abroad costs (provided they fulfill the student eligibility requirements). Please remind students that this is a competitive scholarship that does not guarantee funding for all applicants. In late January 2012, the Summer 2012 student application cycle will open.

STOCS AWARD RECIPIENTS ANNOUNCED:	WEEK OF APRIL 23, 2012
