CUNY SPORT OFFERINGS

Intercollegiate and intramural athletic opportunities are available to students on every CUNY campus. At the varsity level, four-year and community colleges compete on 24 men's and women's teams. Four-year college varsity teams compete in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), while community college teams belong to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA).

All CUNY schools are members of the CUNYAC, The City University of New York Athletic Conference. Citywide CUNYAC championship tournaments in all sports are hotly contested and followed closely by CUNY students and the New York City press. The Commissioner's Cup—one for four-year colleges and one for community colleges—is presented each year to the college with the best overall intercollegiate athletic program.

Additionally, CUNYAC utilizes some of the premier venues in New York City for its championship events, such as the National Tennis Center, Keyspan Park, Icahn Stadium, Metropolitan Oval and the Armory.
